During the workshop we'll experience how different soundboxes effect our vocal expression.

We'll investigate our body as a soundbox bountiful with sounds and voices, using listening exercises, voice production, touch & vibration.

As a group we'll experience with the echo phenomenon, which mirrors our awareness towards our voice and helps to formulate our vocal identity.

In addition we'll create soundboxes in the space using movement & physical sculpture exercises, examining how our surroundings influence our voice production.

The workshop is open to all; previous voice experience is not required.

When & where?

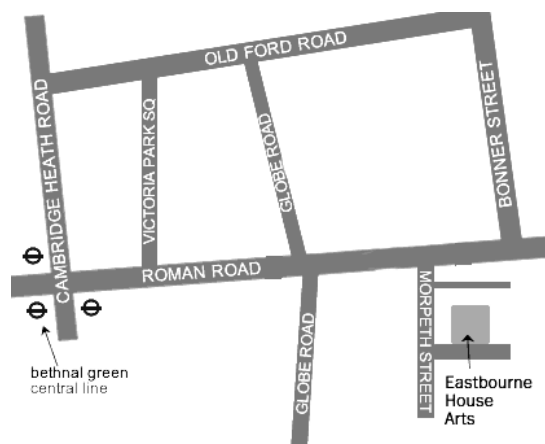
Friday 6/11/09, 7 - 9pm, London Buddhist Arts Centre (LBAC), 2nd floor of Eastbourne House, Bullards Place, E2 OPT (nearest tube station – Bethnal Green).

Fee: £15 / £12 (concession)

Please note: It takes about 10 minutes to walk from the tube station to the studio – please bear this in mind as the workshop will begin at 7pm promptly.

How to get there:

Turn right from Bethnal Green tube station into Roman Road. Walk for about 7 minutes; you'll then see a market place in front of you. Turn right just before it into Morpeth Street ('Greggs' should then be on your left). Take the 2nd turn left to Bullards place; LBAC will be on your left. Ring the 2nd floor bell and climb the steps all the way up to the upper studio.
